MEMBERSHIP PLEDGE



- As a garden member I pledge to abide by the rules of the Manjimup Community Garden (MCG).
- I pledge to attend at least 2 working bees per annum to assist with the maintenance of the MCG.
- I pledge not to interfere with the rights and opportunities of others using the MCG.
- I will carry away non-compostable rubbish and dispose of it off the MCG site.
- When I use tools I will always be aware of the safety of others and myself.
- I will be responsible for the supervision of any children I bring to the MCG.
- I will be responsible for the supervision of any dogs I bring to the MCG. I will scoop up any droppings and dispose of them off the MCG site.
- I understand that my participation at the garden is at my own risk. The MCG is not liable for any injury to me or my invited friends or for the loss of any of my possessions.
- I appreciate the need for security at the MCG and will ensure that I report any suspicious activity to the MCG.
- In order to minimise the export of nutrients and save water, I will only hand water by bucket or watering can as a top up to reticulation that will be supplied.
- If I change my contact details I will notify the MCG by post or email.
- I will abide by organic gardening principles for the management of pests and diseases. I will only use certified organic materials and if the product I want to use does not have certification then I will have the product endorsed by the MCG prior to its use. Non certified organic products already approved for use in the MCG include:
 - ✓ Any animal manure (ideally pre-composted)
 - ✓ Blood & Bone with or without trace elements
 - ✓ Organic 2000 pellets (processed chook poo with lucerne straw)
 - ✓ Rock dust
 - ✓ Sulphur
 - ✓ Bentonite
 - ✓ Seaweed or fish emulsions
 - ✓ Zeolite
- I will not plant any weed species identified in the Department of Parks & Wildlife 'Weeds of the South West Region' document and am aware that MCG has a copy of the document for me to peruse.
- I will familiarise myself with and support any on-site management issues.
