TLILIC2001 - Licence to operate a forklift

This course is run over 2 days from 9:00am to 4:30pm on the following dates:

Thursday 19th & Friday 20th July 2018

Thursday 30th & Friday 31st August 2018

Thursday 13th & Friday 14th September 2018

Thursday 25th & Friday 26th October 2018 Thursday 8th & Friday 9th November 2018 Thursday 6th & Friday 7th December 2018

This course is relevant for anyone wishing to obtain the Nationally Recognised High Risk Work Licence to Operate a Forklift. Minimum age to participate in this course is 18 years of age.

Traffic Management Accreditation

RIIWHS302 - Implement traffic management plan / RIIWHS302 - Control traffic with a stop/slow bat / RIICOM201 - Communicate in the workplace / RIIWHS201 - Work safely and follow WHS policies and procedures

This course is run over 3 days from 9:00am to 4:30pm on the following dates: Tuesday 18th, Wednesday 19th & Thursday 20th September 2018.

This course will provide participants with the knowledge and skills required to be able to safely control traffic with a stop/slow bat in accordance with Main Roads WA requirements and implement basic traffic management plans for works on roads.

Traffic Refresher Course

Express your interest for this one day refresher course. This course will update your knowledge and skills in Traffic Control and Basic Worksite Traffic Management. Traffic controllers are required to renew their MRWA accreditation after three years of

Load Restraint

TLID2004 - Load and unload goods/cargo

Chainsaws

AHCMOM213 - Operate and maintain chainsaws / AHCWHS201 - Participate in work health and safety processes

AusChem Accreditation

AHCCHM303 - Prepare and apply chemicals / **AHCCHM304 - Transport and store chemicals**
